Innermost Gardens – Ania Upstill gave background on Innermost Gardens projects in Wellington. There is a garden at St James Church but they are looking for alternative sites in Newtown. If anyone knows of a vacant site, large back yard or potential ground (not Town Belt) that is sunny and reasonably accessible tell ania.upstill@gmail.com

St James – Alan Shaw (St James Minister) outlined how the number of parishioners at St James had reduced, insurance costs had significantly increased (4000%) and WCC had given notice that the church had to be strengthened within 15 years. Church members now go to Trinity and St Giles. Alternative options to reuse the building have been investigated. The church does not have the funds to maintain or manage the building so has decided to sell the property. In fact they are having difficulty funding the production of a number of reports required for an application to demolish the WCC listed heritage building. Alan will keep in touch about future developments at St James.

Better Local Government - There was concern that 'wellbeing of the community' is no longer a requirement for Local Government in the proposed legislation. The meeting did not agree on a preferred option but wanted a submission to WCC that stated 'Any new model for local government must include strong representation through Local or Community Boards that are sufficiently resourced with powers and budget to effectively represent and manage the needs and wellbeing of local communities'.
